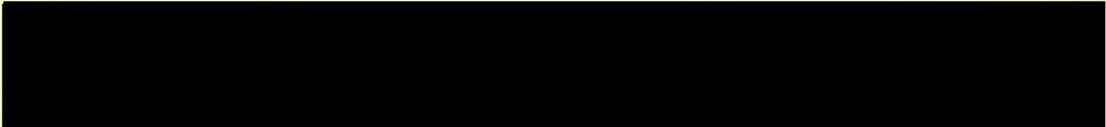

These consist of 897 negatives, taken from 1891-1932 by S.W. Jackson. There is a small collection of personal photographs, but otherwise the subjects are some aspect of Australian natural history. They are mainly birds, with a few botanical subjects and animals - kangaroos, lizards, etc. Some depict aborigines. They are taken principally in New South Wales and Queensland, and some in Tasmania and Western Australia.

There is a small group relating to New Guinea - these are not the work of S.W. Jackson.

The negatives are well described, by place and date, in the list which Ramsay has sent.
